The role

To carry out the daily operation of two CNC machines (Weeke/Homag and Holzher machines) carrying out sizing, milling, morticing and aperture works to timber door leaves. To work from manufacturing drawings & schedules to produce bespoke fire door leaves the operator will be responsible for the programming, maintenance and running of the machinery and supervision of the operatives involved with the same.

The role is shop floor based in our factory in Stockport.

Personal skills

As a skilled & experienced CNC Operator, you must be observant with very good attention to detail.

You should have a logical, methodical approach to your work and you must be accurate when taking measurements and recording figures. Production runs may vary from less than 10 to several hundred units. It is essential that accurate production is maintained.

You will be fully conversant with the capabilities each machine has to offer. You shall be able to understand and use machinery correctly & safely and have a good understanding of fault identification & repair should machines break down.

You shall have good organizational skills and be approachable from those on the shop floor.

No entry level training will be provided as the candidate shall be expected to achieve a competent level immediately, however on going assessment and top up training will be provided.

Entry routes

Candidates will be experienced CNC operators, previously working with timber is essential. Entry will not be possible, as a trainee.
